

Hobby Link US M125 10-ton 6x6 in 1:35 scale by Glen Martin

Since last month, Glen finished this by painting the lights. No clear parts were provided, so these parts were painted with opaque paints. C-ration boxes were added in the bed and the kit markings were added. Glen noted that they were very thin and tended to stick to the model's surface immediately, complicating the positioning process.





Tamiya US M18 Hellcat in 1:35 scale by Alex Valz

No issues were encountered during the build, except that the interior parts needed a bit of dry fitting to properly orient. The tracks are link and length. More paint and weathering remain.







Asuka US M4A1 Sherman in 1:35 scale by Frank Blanton

This build was started years ago. Frank sprayed dark shading at the color boundaries but thinks it might need toning down. The tracks are individual

link upgrades from AFV Club. The turret star is a decal but the remaining markings are from using stencils. The stowage are miscellaneous pieces from the spares box.







Tasca US M4A3 Sherman (early) in 1:35 scale by Frank Blanton

The engine deck is a replacement from Tiger Model Designs and the tow cable was fashioned from twisted wire.







Dragon US M4A1 Sherman in 1:35 scale by Frank Blanton

The front lights have MV Product lens upgrades and the tow cable is made from twisted wire. Light socket caps were added to the brush guards. The tracks are onepiece soft styrene versions from the kit. The tools are resin replacements from Tiger Model Designs.







US M4A3 Sherman Dozer conversion in 1:35 scale by Frank Blanton

This is a Tamiya upper hull and turret, MP Productions lower hull and Dragon DS tracks. The Verlinden dozer blade assembly is all resin. The dozer blade was first

painted gloss black, then airbrushed several metal shades. Dry pigments were applied as a wet mixture and final polishing was done by rubbing it with a #2 pencil.





AFV Club US M5 Stuart in 1:35 scale by Frank Blanton

The turret is a replacement from Tiger Model Designs and the metal tow cable is from Karaya. It was marked with a mixture from Cartograph, Star Decals and Archer

Fine Transfers.



Pass and Review from December



Vargas Scale Models US Mk.VIII Liberty in 1:35 scale by Mike Petty

This 3D-printed kit has only a few major components to assemble. Mike did encounter a dimensional problem when the track sponsons were installed. One side

was sitting too low by 2.5mm and had to be shimmed from underneath to sit level. It was painted Mission Models #25 Olive Drab.



Pass and Review from December



Vargas Scale Models US Christie M1931 in 1:35 scale by Mike Petty

Mike used VMS Flexy 5K 3d CA glue to assemble the model. Fender straps were added that hold the track runs that have been removed for traveling on the wheels.

It was painted Mission Models #25 Olive Drab and marked with a set from Decal Maniacs.





Dragon German VK.45.02(P) in 1:35 scale by Winston Gould

Winston warned that the instructions don't mention a few parts needed for the mantlet and hull MG installation. A MG was added to the commander's cupola to display the model as if it were operational and not just

experimental. The single-run band tracks from the kit were used.





Meng Canadian Leopard C2 MEXAS with Dozer Blade in 1:35 scale by Winston Gould

It's a very nice kit and Winston had no issues. The single-run band tracks from the kit were used and it was painted with Tamiya Color Spray Paint TS-28 Olive Drab 2.







Truck Seat in 1:24 scale by Ashley Abernathy The seat is from a civilian 1950 truck model that Ashley is building, but improving the seat was done just as his demo in the September meeting. Kneadatite A+B putty

was placed on the seat and shaped with dental tools to add contours and stitching lines.
