Tamiya German Tiger I (late)
in $1: 48$ scale

Bob enhanced the base kit with an aftermarket engine, deck screens and metal barrel. The Zimmerit is a separate Tamiya sticker set. The kit's exhaust shields were carefully thinned down to be in scale and
all the hatch handles were removed and replaced with wire. Balsa wood fuel tanks were installed to prevent viewing an empty space beneath the engine deck grates.

The kit is very nice but it had to be painted in stages before assembly could be completed due to the slat armor, which comes in the kit and is molded in styrene. The Tamiya NATO paint set was used.

The model is now in painting stages. Glen prefers to base coat it in Flat Black to allow some shading to show after the first Dunkelgelb layer.

## Pass and Review from July



Takom US M103A1
in $1: 35$ scale
by Glen Martin
The model was painted with Tamiya acrylics, and Glen used a mixture of Olive Drab, Khaki Drab and Black. Different ratios of these colors were used to depict shading.

Dry pigments were added to Turpenoid to make an earth-colored wash that was applied to the model surfaces. The tracks were painted Flat Black, then the rubber pad inside surfaces taped off to protect it from weathering. AK-Interactive metallic paint was applied to the end connectors and the previously mentioned earth wash was
applied and the tape removed. The clear light parts were first painted transparent red then black. The clear periscope parts were painted green on the rear surfaces. Glen's in-box review of this kit is available on the AMPS website.
