Note there is a schedule change in August due to a conflict at the VFW Post. Our meeting will be on Friday, August 18.


July Meeting Demonstration



Tamiya German Tiger I (late) in 1:48 scale by Bob Henry

Bob enhanced the base kit with an aftermarket engine, deck screens and metal barrel. The Zimmerit is a separate Tamiya sticker set. The kit's exhaust shields were carefully thinned down to be in scale and

all the hatch handles were removed and replaced with wire. Balsa wood fuel tanks were installed to prevent viewing an empty space beneath the engine deck grates.






Dragon German Stug III Ausf.G (Italy) in 1:35 scale by Brian Alfano

Brian printed out custom decals for Italian service and applied them over the German Balkenkreuz, just like the period vehicles. More touch ups and weathering remain.





Italeri Italian Semovente M42 da 75/34 in 1:35 scale by Brian Alfano This kit has origins in the 1970s, but this recent release has been updated by including many interior parts. Brian damaged the right front fender by bending and cutting the kit part.





Meng Russian K-4386 Typhoon-VDV in 1:35 scale by Chip Heusinger

A full interior is included with the kit, including decals for the LCD screens and instruments. Chip applied anti-skid paint on the interior floor. Fit so far has been very good.





Meng German Leopard 1A4 (Greece) in 1:35 scale by David Hocheimer Siully Putty was used to mask of the camouflage, starting with green then followed by tan, black and white. David noted that in reference photos, the

camouflage shape and placement varied from vehicle to vehicle.





Rye Field Model German Leopard 2A6M (Canada) in 1:35 scale by David Hocheimer The kit is very nice but it had to be painted in stages before assembly could be completed due to the slat armor, which comes in the kit and is molded in styrene. The Tamiya NATO paint set was used.

Academy German Panzer IV Ausf.H in 1:35 scale by Glen Martin

The model is now in painting stages. Glen prefers to base coat it in Flat Black to allow some shading to show after the first Dunkelgelb layer.

Takom US M103A1 in 1:35 scale by Glen Martin

The model was painted with Tamiya acrylics, and Glen used a mixture of Olive Drab, Khaki Drab and Black. Different ratios of these colors were used to depict shading. Dry pigments were added to Turpenoid to make an earth-colored wash that was applied to the model surfaces. The tracks were painted Flat Black, then the rubber pad inside surfaces taped off to protect it from weathering. AK-Interactive metallic paint was applied to the end connectors and the previously mentioned earth wash was

applied and the tape removed. The clear light parts were first painted transparent red then black. The clear periscope parts were painted green on the rear surfaces.
